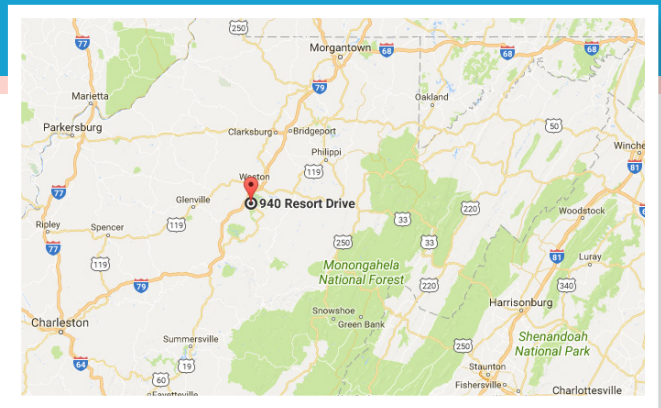
The conference will be held at the Stonewall Jackson Resort in Roanoke, WV. Rooms have been reserved at the Stonewall Jackson Resort.
